

Flying Feathers

Flying feathers is a traditional American Indian game of skill and accuracy.

Do not start until the signal is given.

Game Basics

Construct darts that will be used to throw at targets.

Rules of the game

1. Using the materials provided, plus your ingenuity, each patrol member will assemble and decorate his/her own Flying Feather. Feather construction and design can vary between patrol members, but each feather must include a common element that identifies the patrol to which it belongs.
2. Once the entire patrol has completed construction of its Flying Feathers the patrol will move in mass to its designated land and go hunting using appropriate lane safety measures.
3. When all patrol members have tossed their Flying Feathers the patrol is to give its patrol cheer.
4. When hunting is over and the signal, to retrieve the Flying Feathers is given, one designated patrol member will retrieve the patrol's Flying Feathers and construct a patrol fan for their totem.

Equipment needed

1. Materials to make darts
 - a. Feathers
 - b. Glue
 - c. Fishing weight
 - d. Pointed object (pins, quills, etc.)
2. Targets
3. Safety Rules

Scoring

Based on values assigned to targets.
